This is a summary of how our school delivers music education to all our pupils across three areas – curriculum music, co-curricular provision and musical experiences – and what changes we are planning in future years. This information is to help pupils and parents or carers understand what our school offers and who we work with to support our pupils' music education.

Part A: Curriculum music

This is about what we teach in lesson time, how much time is spent teaching music and any music qualifications or awards that pupils can achieve.

KS1: 10 weeks of BYMT lessons each year; rest of year covered by Charanga KS2: 15 weeks of Music lead lessons each year; rest of year covered by Charanga
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Part B: Co-curricular music

This is about opportunities for pupils to sing and play music, outside of lesson time, including choirs, ensembles and bands, and how pupils can make progress in music beyond the core curriculum.

KS1: Private music lessons taught by BYMT specialists where requested Daily listening opportunities during assemblies KS2: Ensemble choir for Year 4 children upwards School orchestra for children working at Grade 1 upwards Band on the Run project available to all of KS2

Performances at assembly level from orchestra and choir
Rocksteady project available to whole school

Part C: Musical experiences

This is about all the other musical events and opportunities that we organise, such as singing in assembly, concerts and shows, and trips to professional concerts.

EYFS: Christmas concert
KS1: pBuzz termly performance and Christmas concert; weekly singing assembly
KS2: Christmas concert; weekly singing assembly
KS1 and 2: Annual Music Showcase; music assemblies
All: Annual Music Immersion Day
