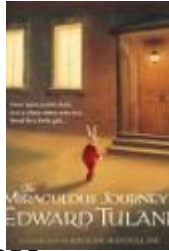


Year 4 - Summer 1 Curriculum Overview

English: This term we will be reading 'The Miraculous journey of Edward Tulane' and writing for different purposes:

- Diary entry



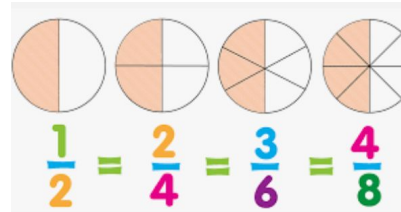
The toolkit

This term we will be learning about:

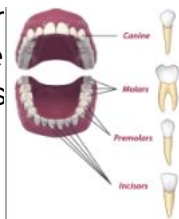
- Fractions

Science:

Our topic is 'Animals including humans'. This term we will be learning about:

- The digestive system in humans
- Identify different types of teeth in humans and their functions
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains.



History

Our topic is the Romans.

Pupils will recap the ways in which the Romans changed Britain and then learn about the changes that happened when they left. They will continue to develop their chronological understanding of the history of Britain and will look at early Anglo-Saxon migration, settlement and beliefs.



Art

Our topic is printing. We will be making printing tools to make repeated patterns. We will be learning about the artist Paul Klee and about African Kente cloth.



RE

Our topic is Buddhism.

Children will be empowered to answer the enquiry questions: What is the best way for a Buddhist to lead a good life?

Do all religious beliefs influence people to behave well towards others?

PSHE

Our topic is Relationships. We will be discussing:

- How relationships change.
- Identifying special people in our lives.
- How we remember people.
- How to manage falling out with friends.
- How I can be loved.

Music

This term the children will be continuing their learning of playing the recorder with Mr Mannoukas.



PE

Our topic is striking and fielding in cricket. We will be participating in coaching sessions through the 'Time to shine' program.
