

# Year 3 Summer 1 Curriculum Newsletter

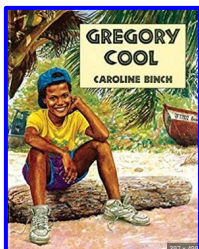

## English

We will be learning about:

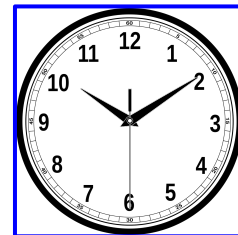
- Using paragraphs

We will be learning about the different parts of a plant and their function. Children will also learn how new plants are made, the stages of pollination and how seeds are dispersed.



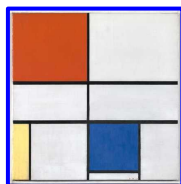
## History
